SECTION – C (graves must be in rotation)

Regular grave opening chargers: \$695.00. There will be an extra charge of \$150.00 on Saturdays and \$250.00 on Sundays and Holidays.

An additional charge of \$100.00 will be added if snow removal is required. There will be an extra charge on grave closings after 4:00 pm. of \$250.00. Cremation openings and closings are \$200.00. (Ask the Funeral Director questions about the Cremation.)

Unaffiliated non-members must remit all additional charges at time of purchase. Affiliated non-member must remit additional charges at time of purchase or at time of burial, if lot owned by member. No additional non-member fee would be charged former members who have moved from the congregation, providing they had been active members of St. Lucas for a period of ten years or more following their 25th birthday and had purchased a lot before leaving the congregation. No refund will be made should membership status change after payment of a non-member fee. Any situation of doubt as to membership status will be decided by the Lutheran Memorial Park Board and their decision will be final.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF RELATIVES AND FRIENDS OF DECEASED

- Christmas wreaths and artificial decorations – need to be removed by Palm Sunday.
- Easter decorations – need to be removed by Memorial Day.
- Funeral flowers – should be removed from grave one week after burial.
- Fresh or potted flowers are permitted at gravesites until they become wilted or unsightly and then need to be removed.
- Flags may be placed in metal holders on graves between Memorial Day & Labor Day.
- Glass vases, bottles or tin cans are not permitted at any time.
- Flowers may be planted in a cultivated bed on graveside of the grave marker. The bed shall extend no more than 14 inches in front of and no wider than the grave marker.
- Fall clean-up must be completed by October 15th
- There will be no home made upright monuments. (Crosses).
- **Plan to take all refuse with you for disposal, as the Cemetery does not have garbage pickup.**

Note: If you make a donation in the “Cemeteries” envelope in your packet and wish it to be given to Lutheran Memorial Park it must be marked as such.
