#### FORWARD: OUR GREAT OPPORTUNITY

The Forward capital campaign giving season is off and running. It is our prayer that the Lord would bless our congregation with the resources to build a worship facility that will bring glory to God, provide for the needs of his people, and be inviting to the community we seek to serve with the gospel of Jesus.

Now is your opportunity to commit to working together to make the vision of a new church building a reality. If you have not done so already, please return a commitment card outlining your gift to the Lord for the purpose of building his house. That gift is one way of thanking the Lord for all he has given you. Commitment forms are available online, in the back of church, and outside the school office. They may be placed in the red box in the back of church or dropped off at the office during the week.

The giving season for the campaign has started and will continue through March 2025. Simply place your check in a church building fund envelope, or donate online through our website. We pray that the Lord blesses all of us with the joy of giving cheerfully. As of March 31, 2023, the Lord has blessed us to have a balance of \$1,918,364.43 in the church building fund (see attached treasurer's report). We praise God for the generous gifts over the years which have brought us to this point.

The Church Building Coordinating Task Force continues working on refining the conceptual plan that was presented to the congregation. Your input has been appreciated. In the back church are updated drawings which include a potential covered drive up for the entrance. Building the covered drive up requires a variance from the Village of Kewaskum to build closer than 25 feet from the street. We will pursue that variance at the proper time. Another suggestion for a family restroom, where a person with disabilities would be able to receive assistance, has been passed on to the architect and he is working on the best location for this type of restroom.

We are blessed to work with a team of professionals who have great experience working with churches, including several WELS churches in our area. Our capital campaign coordinator is Generis, based in Atlanta, Georgia. The architect is from Groth Design Group in Cedarburg. The building coordinator is from Catalyst Construction, whose founder and CEO is a fellow WELS member.
