FORWARD: THE NEXT STEPS

The Church Building Coordinating Task Force will be working with Groth Design Group to complete construction drawings so that when the financing becomes available, and the congregation approves the project, we will be ready to move forward with construction. The Task Force will be meeting with Groth Design Group and Catalyst Construction on Monday, July 1, to get this next step in the process moving. We are working on a plan that will give us a move in ready church building for \$5.3 million.

The Task Force is pursuing a building loan with a different lender from the one they had already worked with. The goal is to arrange a building loan with the best terms possible. The loan committee of Waukesha State Bank will be considering our loan application at their meeting on July 10. We pray that the Lord would bless our efforts to secure funding to build a new building in which we will worship him.

The Task Force asks for your continued prayers and input as we move ahead with the planning process. Think ahead of how you would be able to volunteer to keep the building costs lower. Of course, your generous financial offerings to the Lord for the carrying out of this project will help bring it to completion.
